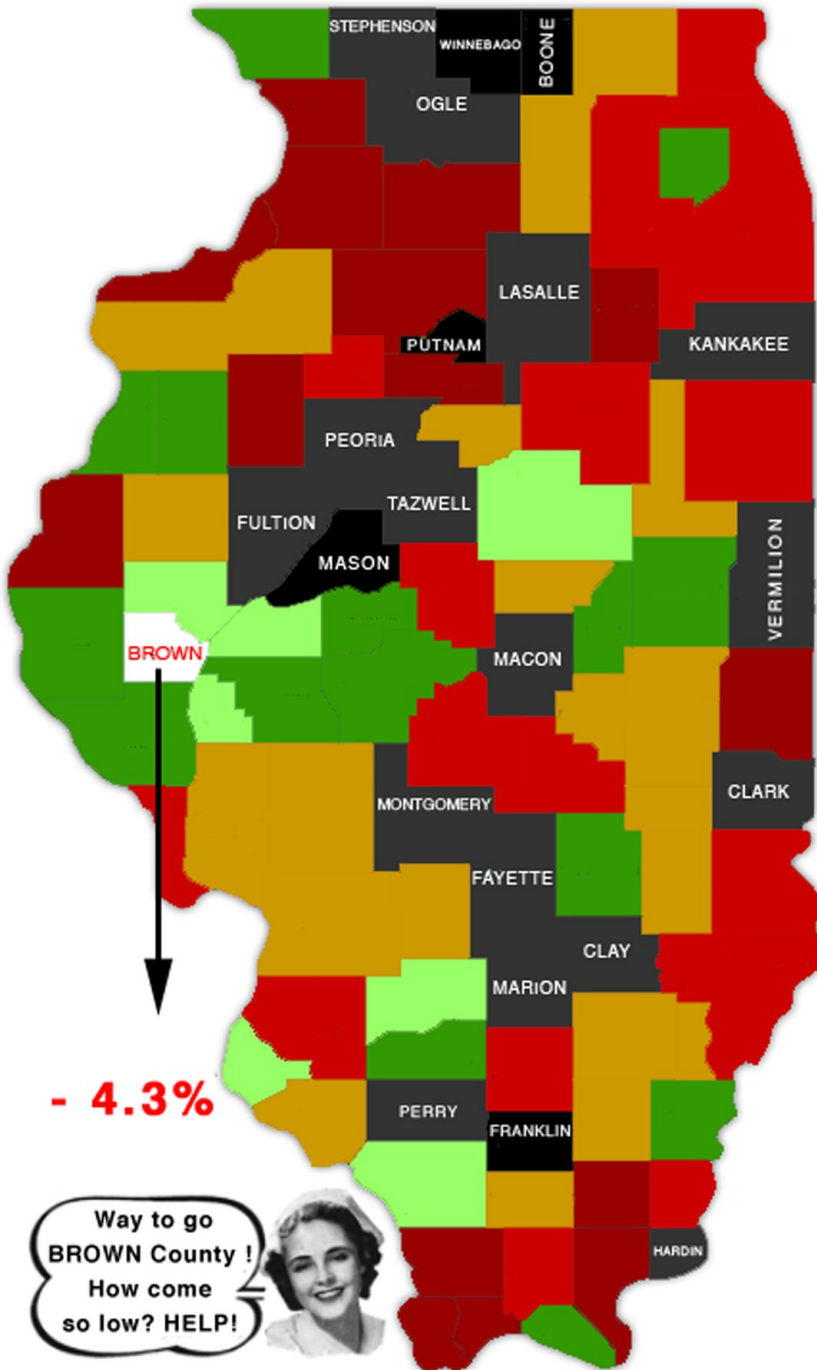
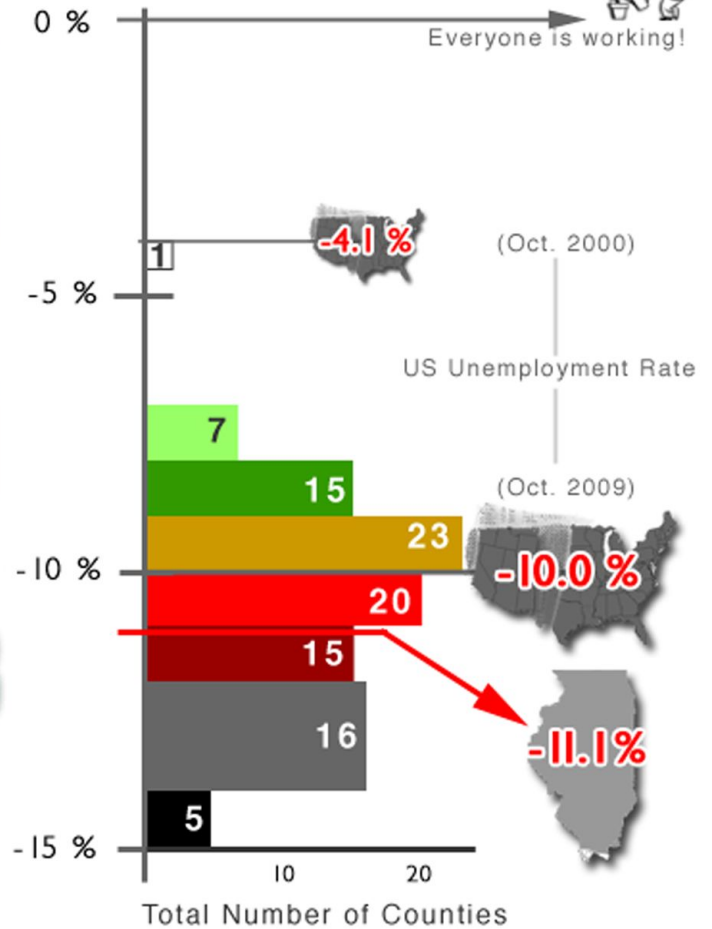


ILLINOIS UNEMPLOYMENT RATES
